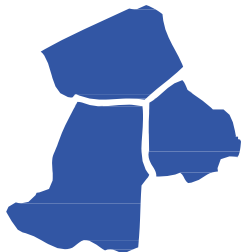


Accomplishments

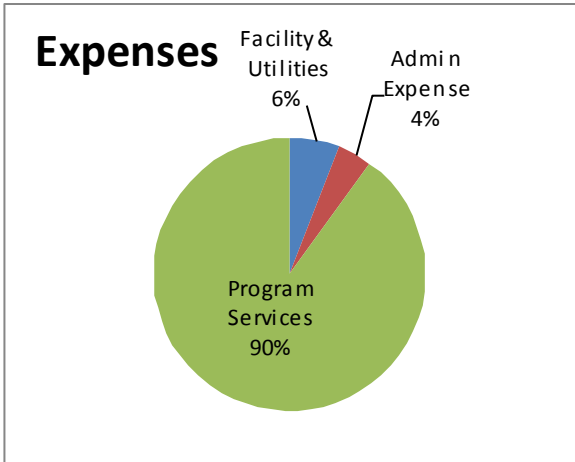
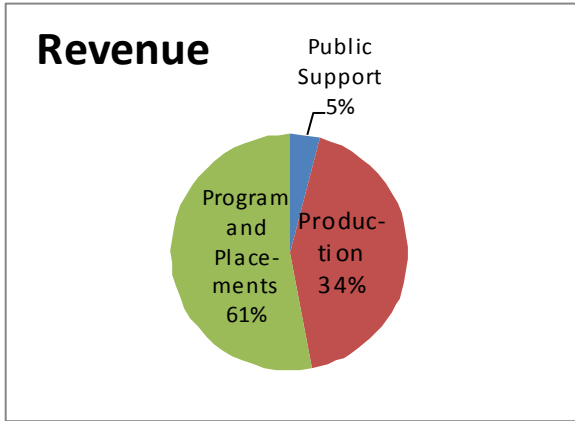
DOI’s Economic Impact On The Community
